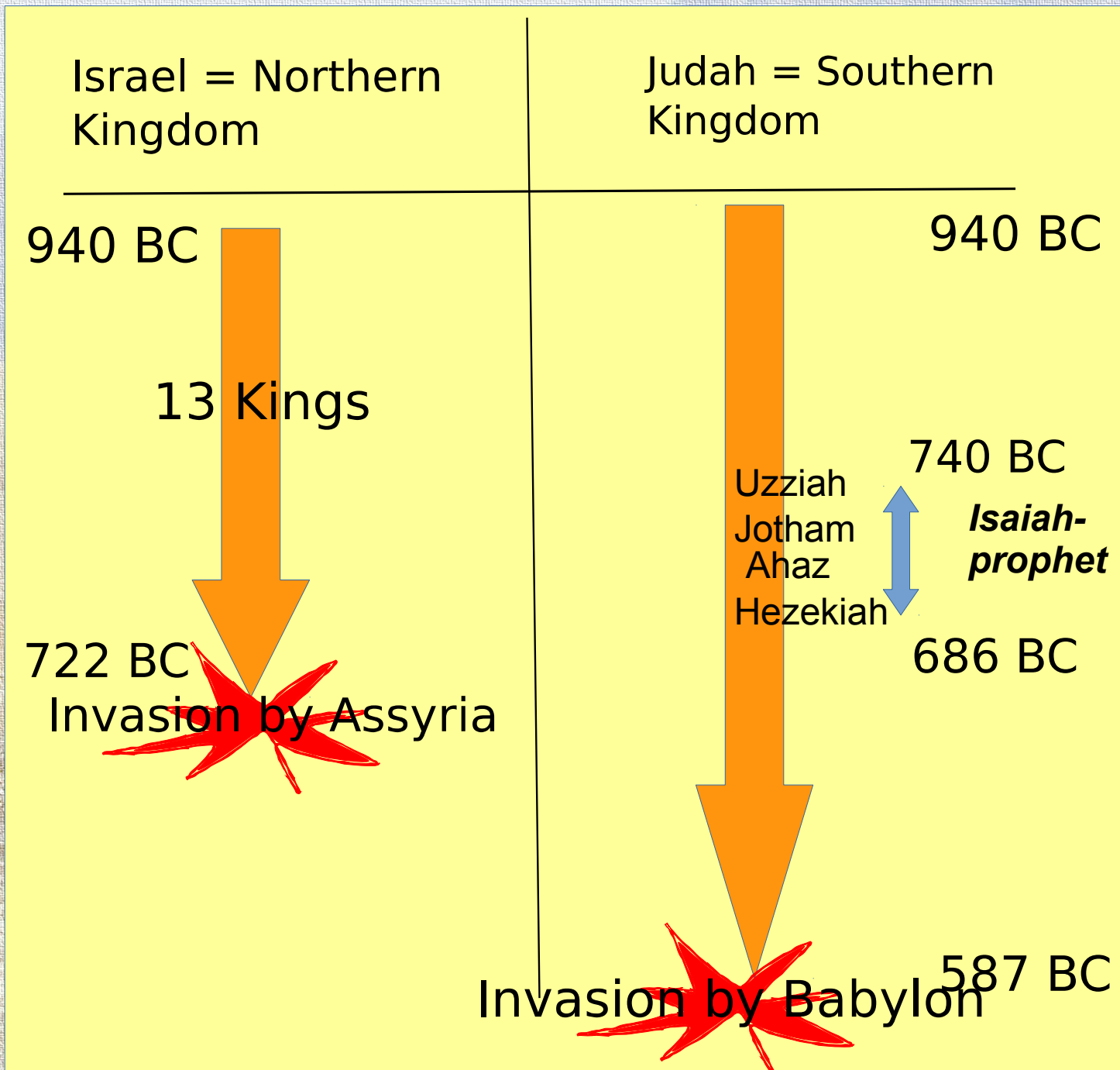

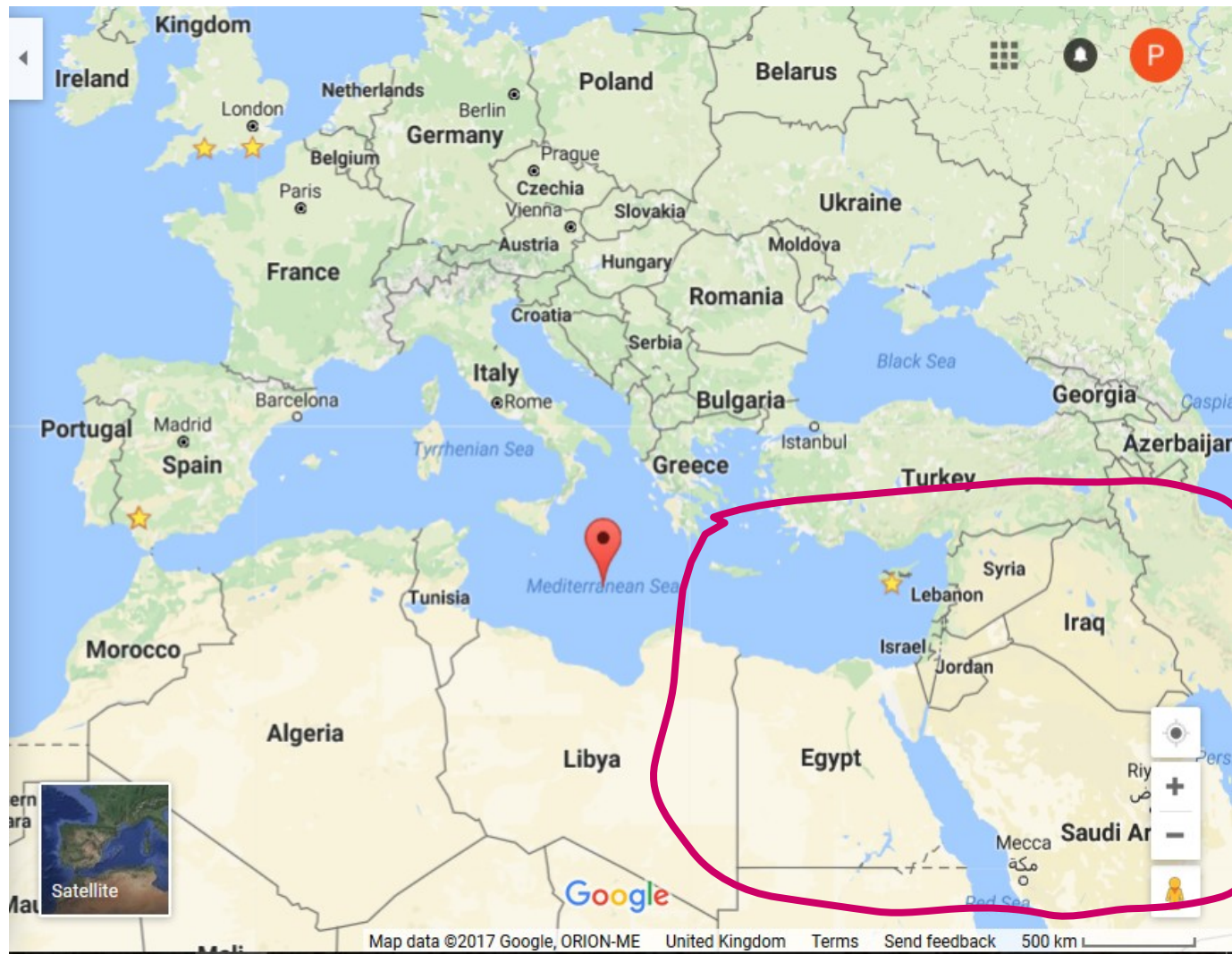

- able to edit his material before he died

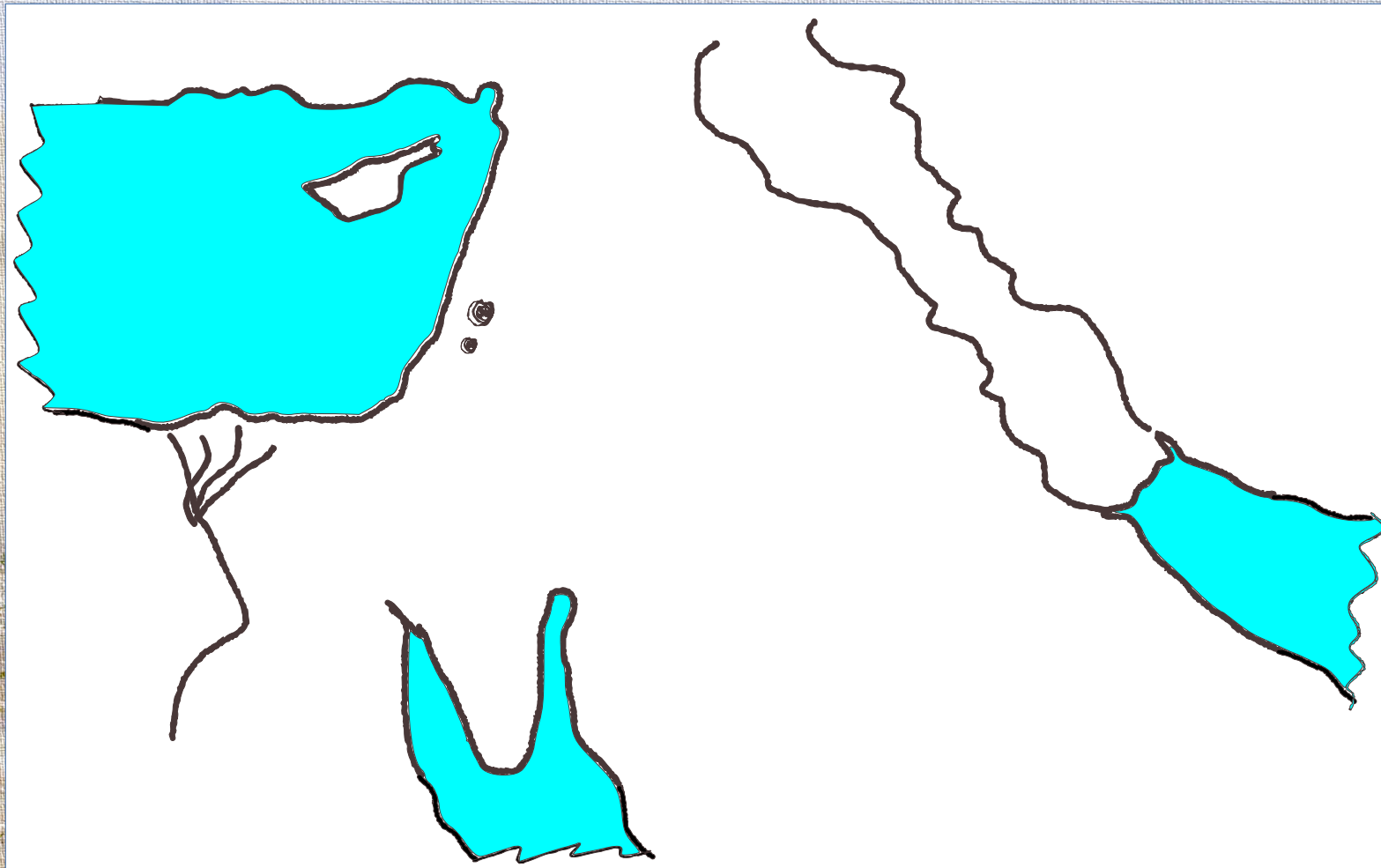

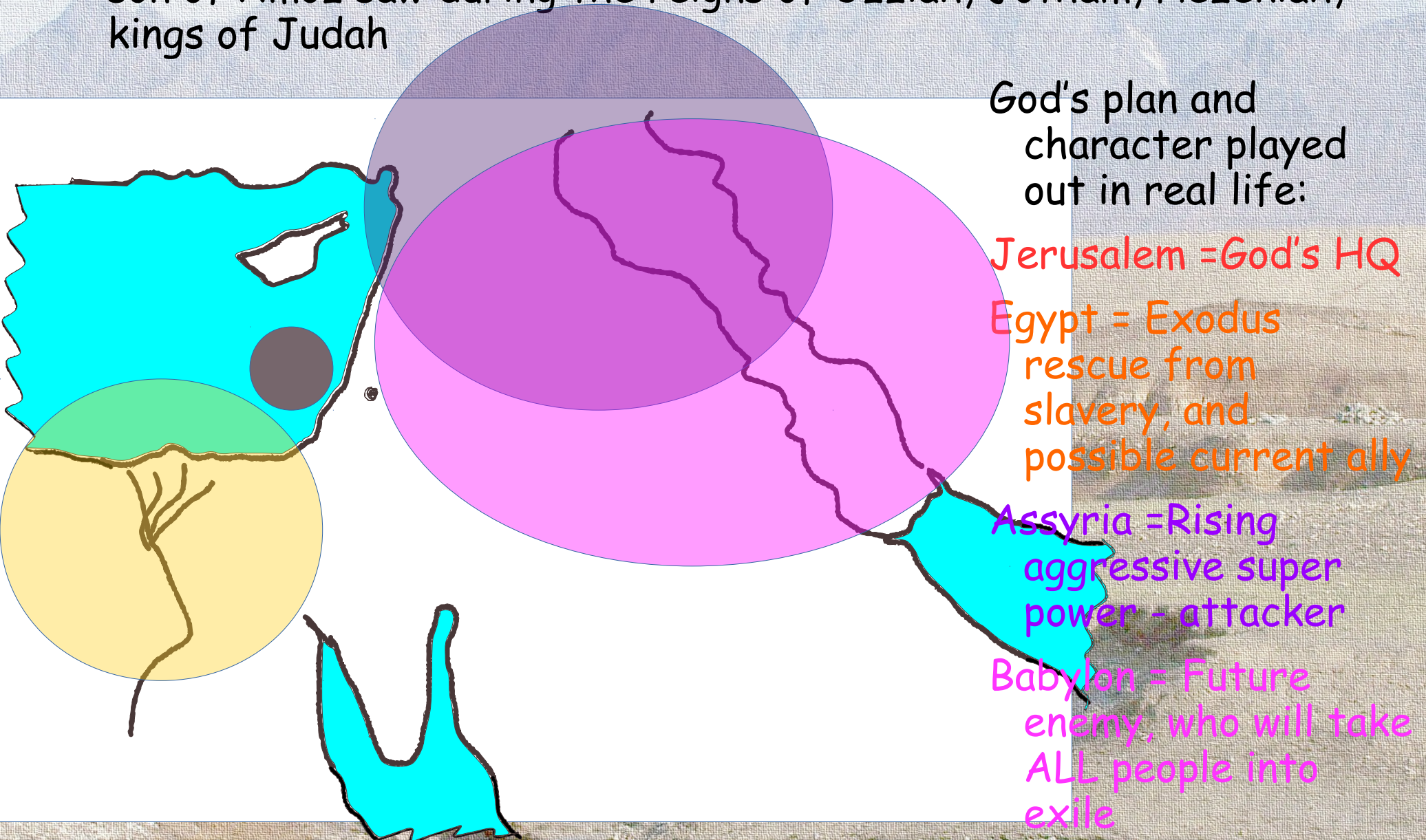
