


- Objection: there is no such thing as church membership in the New Testament.
 - Unnecessary
 - useless,
 - Legalistic
 - Opposed to the main points of Christianity
 - Answer: there is no reference or ceremony called "membership" in the N.T.
 - (likewise no word/title "Trinity"! But it is there throughout the NT)
 - BUT the ideas that we (=Calvary) mean by Church Membership flood the New testament

It is very very very clear that N.T. Christianity is all about a functioning community that is ordered from outside this world



- Fundamental New testament themes formal church membership is saying "yes" to these (not "no"not "no"/"sometime"/"maybe")
- 1. Love John 13:34 a promise to real people somewhere
- 2. service Mark 10:42
- 3. gifts Romans 12:1-8
- 4. interdependence 1 Corinthians 12:4-6 //12-26
- 5. unity/variety as above
- 6. accountability (formal and informal) Matthew 18:15-18
- 7. a mission/purpose 1 Timothy 3:14
- 8. a shared beginning Acts 2:38-41
- 9. a shared meal 1 Cor 10:20-21

Fundamental New testament themes - church membership is formally (actually) saying "yes" to these (not "no"/"sometime"/"maybe")

A church member is

- NOT a super Christian ... a normal Christian
- young or old
- new or experienced
- overwhelmed by the flood or walking on water
- highly educated or not good at reading
- a doctor, a barrister, a single parent, seeking work, English, Albanian,
- BUT IS someone who says YES to the whole package of following Jesus

Pastor Les Hill (came 1964- died 1989)

- Loved the Lord and his Word and his
 House including cooking for 20
- Had an open home for international students inc. John Benton
- Learned and taught Reformed grasp of salvation, through considerable opposition
- Reformed = Calvinistic (like 39 articles) =
 God rules, God saves by his grace, I was lost and dead in sin, to him be the glory
- With AP (Gerald and Howard then Philip 1979)
- Plurality of elders
- Need for full-time elder (John Cropley)
- Consecutive expository word-ministry

Pastor Les Hill (came 1964 - died 1989)

Being Evangelical Reformed Christians =???

- Antiquarian? ("thou dost")
- Separatist? (e.g. from Anglicans)
- Modern songs? (e.g. Graham Kendrick)
- Church culture? (e.g. dark suits, hats & silence)
- "forsake not the assembling of yourselves together as the manner of some is"
 Hebrews 10:25
- Responsibility of members (not all down to "them" and "the Pastor")
- Doctrines of grace and gracious character

- Richard Hart "is there a reason why God would want a church [based] in Preston Circus [rather than anywhere else]"


