

# Repeated aim

- This is a series of 6 about the nature and cohesion of the communities of Jesus Christ (i.e. churches)

#### 1. Love

What about mentions in the documents of the first generation communities of Jesus?

#### Answer: it's difficult to mention them all!

- Romans 12: [gifts] 9 Love must be sincere ... Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honour one another above yourselves ..."
- Galatians 5:22 "the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control"
- 1 Corinthians 13 "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud, it is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres ...
- ==> the New Testament breathes love
- ==> ...shines love
- ==> ... lays the ground works in love
- ==> ... pays the hefty bills in love


==> ministry of the word: building the church and predening to the unconverted is robust and humble

# 4. Accountability

Q: What is meant by accountability? (vs- Western Individualism)

A: that way of living in which I accept that my spiritual life is bound up with the spiritual life of my brothers and sisters

And that I, by my sin, can harm myself and them, and that they have a right to rebuke me

And that I have a duty to seek their best interests by rebuking them for their good.

That I have **no right** to live without concern for my affect on them. That I have **no right** to live without concern to rebuke them for their good.

- = That we live in a community/body whose sinews and ligaments are responsibility and accountability
- ==> informal discipline, formal discipline

## 5,6 Gifts


e.g. Romans 12
