


A.Christmas message

A Christmas message

- "It is a superstitious intrusion into an otherwise rational world [evidence-based]"
 - Without real-world basis
- Depends on what is the "real world"!
 - Real world of only what can be measured with a ruler, or seen with a microscope
 - can't even detect "love", "beauty" let alone "angels", "miracles", unique events in history
 - Evidence of changed lives, key that fits the lock of ... life the universe and everything
 - Testimony of honest people in the past
 - "I've written so that you can know the certainty of these things ..." (1:4)
 - God has acted to show, and confirm favour to our needy r

- "Yes ... it's good to get the Christmassy feel (+It's a wonderful life, A Christmas Carol ... Patrick Stewart)"
 - Definitely feelings!
 - · Mary was greatly troubled " at the angel's arrival
 - · The shepherds were "terrified"
 - · Good news of "great joy"
 - · All the people who heard were "amazed"
- Feelings and moods ... response to something true that goes deeper and lasts longer than the feeling or mood itself
- I hope you feel Christmassy, but I hope you won't miss the fact that the events of Christmas apply all year round ... till there are no more years
