Easter Sunday - the Resurrection of Jesus

Marmite

- you love it or hate it
- it divides the country
- invented by Justus von Liebig
- Jesus' resurrection - divides humanity (future/present)
- be on the right side of the division!

Easter Sunday - the Resurrection of Jesus

Tell the story in 5 scenes 1,2,3,2,5 show the 2 sides

Spoiler Alert! - Behold! = See! x6 (v.2,7,7,9,20) - Jesus x5

- all x4

1. between the death and the burial - Joseph asks for the body - Joseph buries the body N.B. "new tomb" - normal closing ... he [=?] rolled a stone "mega" - he went away - Mary & other Mary continued sitting there ==> seems rather worthy but forlorn!

2. Opponents meeting

- chief priests (~ Sadducees) + Pharisees "synagogue" with Pilate
- "Sir" = kyrie = Lord
- Jesus = deceiver (v.63) ... deception (v.64)
- they know that Jesus prophesied "after 3 days I will rise"
- Pilate: either "you have [your own] guard OR "take a guard [of my soldiers]"
- to prevent body stealing v.64
- Pilate: make secure (v. 64,65,66), as best you know
- guard, stone, seal (CCTV, tanks etc. would have made no difference!)
- ==> humanly speaking ... very sensible plan (do they know who
 they are up against?)

3a. At the tomb

- after the Sabbath (i.e. "Sunday")
- Mary + Mary [+?]
- mega earth quake FOR the angel of the Lord came down from heaven
- rolled away the stone, sat on it.
- appearance = lightning, clothes
 white as snow
- → guards quaked
- → like dead people
- ==> who seems fragile, futile?

3b at the tomb: the words of the angel

- The words of the angel
 - [to women] Do not be afraid
 - you seek Jesus who was crucified
 - he is not here, he is risen
 - Come see the [empty] place where they laid him
 - Go quickly tell his disciples
 - Behold: He has risen FROM THE DEAD PEOPLE
 - Going ahead of into Galilee
 - There you [=men] will see him
 - Behold I have spoken to you
 - ==> entirely Jesus-centred!

3c Running with good news

- The response of the women
 - Go quickly / run fear & joy mega
 - To "good-news"/report-to the disciples
- And Behold! Jesus met them
 - cheers/rejoice
 - Seize his feet and worship/fall-down-honour
- Jesus says
 - Do not fear
 - Go "good-news"/report back to my brothers
 - That they should go to Galilee
 - Where they will see me
 - ==> how wonderful to see him, confirm his words!

4=2 Back at opposition HQ The guards go into the city

- "good-news"/report back to chief priests
- Plan ... bribe ... [deception] ... steal body ... we sleep
- Don't worry
- Soldiers did as taught
- Was widely circulated ... but untrue
- ==> which is based on make-believe??

5. Back in Galilee mountain (v.16-20) They saw

- They worshipped
- Some were bewildered (? fear/joy? Worship?)
- Jesus came and said:
 - All authority in heaven and earth
 - Go and make disciples of all nations
 - Baptising them in the name
 - Teaching them to keep all I have commanded you
 - I am with you all the days
 - ==> set on a mission (c.f. this evening)

Did you notice?

- N.B. Objections rebuffed:
 - There were other bodies in the tomb!
 - "new"
 - The women went to the wrong place!
 - They had watched carefully
 - Isolated and unreliable testimony!
 - 2 women, 11 disciples
 - The body was absent because stolen!
 - Known to be untrue: lies, bribery, invention
- N.B. vibes of power nuclear holiness fear joy
 - Mega!

Two similar but opposite communities

- Jesus & Disciples ressn
 - Galilee-based
 - Nations are discipled
 - Women + disciples (64, 28:7,8,16,19)
 brothers
 - Jesus as loved
 - Power of heaven (angel), creation (quake)
 ... roll the stone away!
 - Dead become alive
 - Good-news "he is risen"
 - Instructed by Jesus
 - Sleepers raised (27:52)
 - Keep my commandments
 - ==> truthful, worshipful, positive mission
 - ==> this is the community of Jesus! Please deal with God so that you get into it!

- Opponents death
 - Jerusalem-based
 - Nations conspire
 - CP, Ph, P., guards
 - Jesus as deceiver, deception
 - Sealed & secured as best you know
 - Become as dead
 - Good-news report "We failed"
 - Instructed with a lie for a bribe
 - "fell asleep"
 - Keep (28:4) [him in the grave]
 ==> based on a lie, deliberately hostile, futile
