Problem solving -now

- In a world Created by God
 - · God who is Personal, Infinite, Moral
- World with order
- World with relationship
- How to solve?
- e.g. sexual problems ... loneliness
 - Solved through pornography?
- e.g. mental problems ... anxiety, fear
 - · Solved through alcohol? Substances
- e.g. financial problems ... debt?
 - · Solved through theft? Cheating? (Smart?)


What about genuinely asking God for help??

Problem solving - then ... Old Testament

- In a nation created and redeemed by God
 - · God who is Personal, Infinite, Moral




- Nation with relationship I.e. clearly stated promises and commitments from LORD God ("covenant")
- How to solve?
- -e.g. military/political problem
 - · By partying alcohol
 - · By planning "smoke-filled rooms" intelligence
 - · By ignoring
 - · By rituals, superstitions
- BUT NOT by listening to God's word
- WOE! = judgment, emotion, sympathy





Problem solving



Northern Kingdom

- Called Ephraim
- Or Israel
- Broke away from King
 David, and temple and
 adopted idol worship
- Lush farming
- Was overrun by Assyria


Southern Kingdom

- Called Judah
- HQ = Jerusalem / Zion
- Had city of David, temple

The problem of the surrounding nations

Isaiah 7:1 "... king of Israel marched against Jerusalem"

2 Kings 16:7 "Ahaz sent messengers to ... king of Assyria ... I am your servant ... come up and save me ... took silver and gold from temple and sent it as a gift to the King of Assyria"





Jerusalem =God's HQ


Egypt = Exodus

Assyria = Rising aggressive
Super power - Office security, but turns into

deadly enemy









Problem solving - but they reject LORD's word

They say "who is Isaiah talking to?"


- Does he think he is talking to babies?? (we're grown up!)
- His talk is simplistic ("do,do,do")

God says

- If you won't listen when I talk to you in our own language
- Then the only talk you will get is the chat of foreign soldiers
- When people don't believe and hear gobbldygook it is [a sign of] God's judgment

Problem solving in Jerusalem - the stone


[God's precious problem solving method]


See I place a stone in Zion

- Tested stone, precious corner, sure foundation
- Who trusts in him NOT put to shame
- "mishpat" is the measuring line ...

Who is he?

- "see I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame" 1. Peter 2:6
- "you have tasted that the Lord is good. As you come to him, the living stone rejected by men but chosen by God and precious to him you also are like living stones, are being built up into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood ... to you who believe this stone is precious" 1 Peter 2:4
- Do we come? Shall we come? Is he precious to us as he is to God?





Problem solving - plans of the powerful are stupid

Even the simple peasant farmer

- knows what to plant
- God teaches him "mishpat" v.26



Even the peasant farmer

- Knows how to treat his harvest
- From the LORD wonderful in counsel and wisdom

[But you Kings and Priests haven't got a clue!]



Problem solving - "Ariel" the ritualistic planner

WOE to Ariel (= Jerusalem v.8)

- //"altar hearth" they have lots of rituals (v.1)

- God send the attacker, make her a hearth v.2

BUT God will repel the attacker v.6

- Zion staggers (not wine)
- sleep ... blinded ... deaf
- she also cannot hear God's voice
- she talks the talk, but her heart is far away from God (v.13)
- her clever plans will be frustrated (v.14)

1 Cor 1:19 - they never really understood, because they didn't understand the cross



Problem solving - "Ariel" the ritualistic planner

WOE to those who plan and hide it from the LORD

- it's like a pot saying that the potter has no knowledge (Romans 9:20)
- BUT God will
 - Make the field fertile (v.17)
 - Make the dear hear
 - The blind see
 - The humble rejoice
 - The ruthless disappear



Problem solving - summary The party animals of Ephraim

- Be trampled

The priests and prophets

- Stupid with wine
- wouldn't hear → couldn't hear

The rulers of Jerusalem - covenant makers

- Their covenant with death
- God against them (strange work)
- N.B. even farmers learn better than them

Ariel -full of ritual

- Sozzled by religion = blind, deaf

The despised word we need to hear

The stone - the basis for all solutions

- Trust in him is the fundamental
- He is precious
- He is wisdom, and power, in his cross
- He is Jesus
