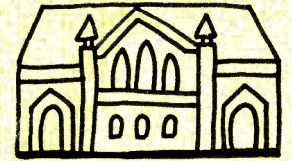

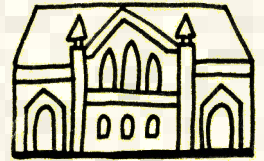

Q; different churches?

Last time: churches,

Catholic, Protestant, Pentecostal, Baptist

Anglican, Methodist ...

... all different sort of churches

... does it matter? Are they all the same?

Answer: the main thing is "if you listened openly  
to their message would you hear the gospel"

(==> implications about what actually a Christian  
is)

# What is Gospel?

Gospel = good news

Old English: good+spel ...

Original Greek: Ev-angel ...

(hence *evangelical* church, gospel church)



# What is the gospel?

*What the apostle Paul tells us*

*"By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly ...Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures that he was buried that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures"* 1 Corinthians 15:3,4

- message (words), to be believed ("held firmly")
- about Jesus Christ
- about his death and resurrection
- the Scriptures are where it is found (OT+NT)
- it deals with sin ... sp. Forgiveness, removal of guilt and shame
- it is the only way to be saved v.2

# How does someone become a Christian?

## How does someone come to have this faith that saves?

- faith, not formality (e.g. baptised as a baby)
- needed faith: not everyone has it
- how do some have faith?
  - Clever?
  - Spiritual?
  - ... or is it a gift?
  - ... do we look for the answer deep within God, rather than within the believer?
  - *"I was such a blind, self-centred, lost sinner, I would never have believed in God unless I he had opened my eyes and my heart ... not my choice, but yours"*

# How does someone become a Christian

## Drill down about becoming a Christian ...

- sin - how bad?
  - Is there a bit of goodness left, or is the human heart so anti-God that the person is incapable of choosing God
- God's choice to open my heart
  - 50% ... 75% ... 100%
- Christ's death for sin:
  - potentially die for my sin? or so definitely paid for that there was zero chance that I would pay for my own sins
- the effect of God's choice
  - Potentially successful, or once chosen WILL be saved
- the future
  - If God chooses to save me, and Christ died for my sin - in the final purposes of God ... is there a chance that I will not make it to heaven



# How does someone become a Christian

Drill again - precise words about becoming a christian ...

- TULIP (1905, 1932, 1963??) -
    - = a slogan version of "Reformed" understanding of salvation
  - Total depravity - sin makes people incapable
  - Unconditional election - God chooses people
  - L : Particular Redemption - Christ actually died for his people
  - I irresistible grace : various forms of grace ("God's mercy and undeserved kindness in action") ... but there is one form that guarantees that it will accomplish what it set out to do
  - P: preservation of the saints: God can keep his people and bring them through right to the end
- => these are the ideas, but are they true?



# How does someone become a Christian

About becoming a christian ...

- TULIP ... = "God chooses"

- Objection:

If God chooses people then (logically) there is no point in trying to persuade them... they will come if he has chosen them

A. God has also chosen the method by which they will come. Method = human beings speaking to fellow human beings

# How does someone become a Christian

## About becoming a christian ...

God chooses

God ordains preaching to the lost

... is it true?

... is it right?

... is it what Paul said (or just human thinkers ...  
Augustine, Calvin, Puritans, John Piper ...)

... **is it what Jesus said ???**

- look at what Jesus said on this subject
- Implications
- Follow up this evening

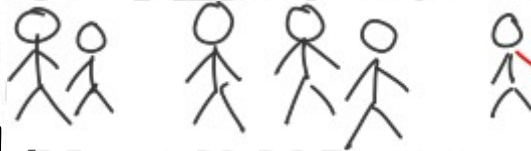

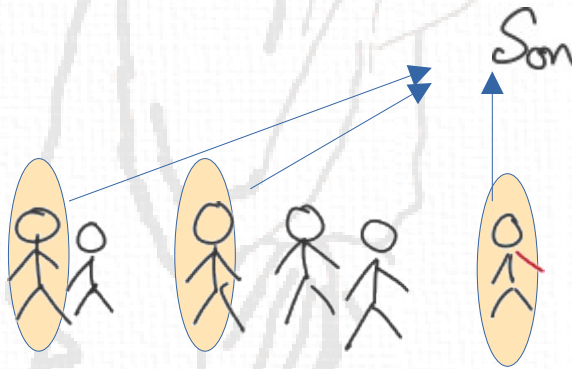
# What did Jesus say?

What is the Father's will?

To whom does it apply? Who does this? (v.37.v.39)

How many people does the Father give who do not come? v.45,

How many people come whom the Father does not give v.44, v.65

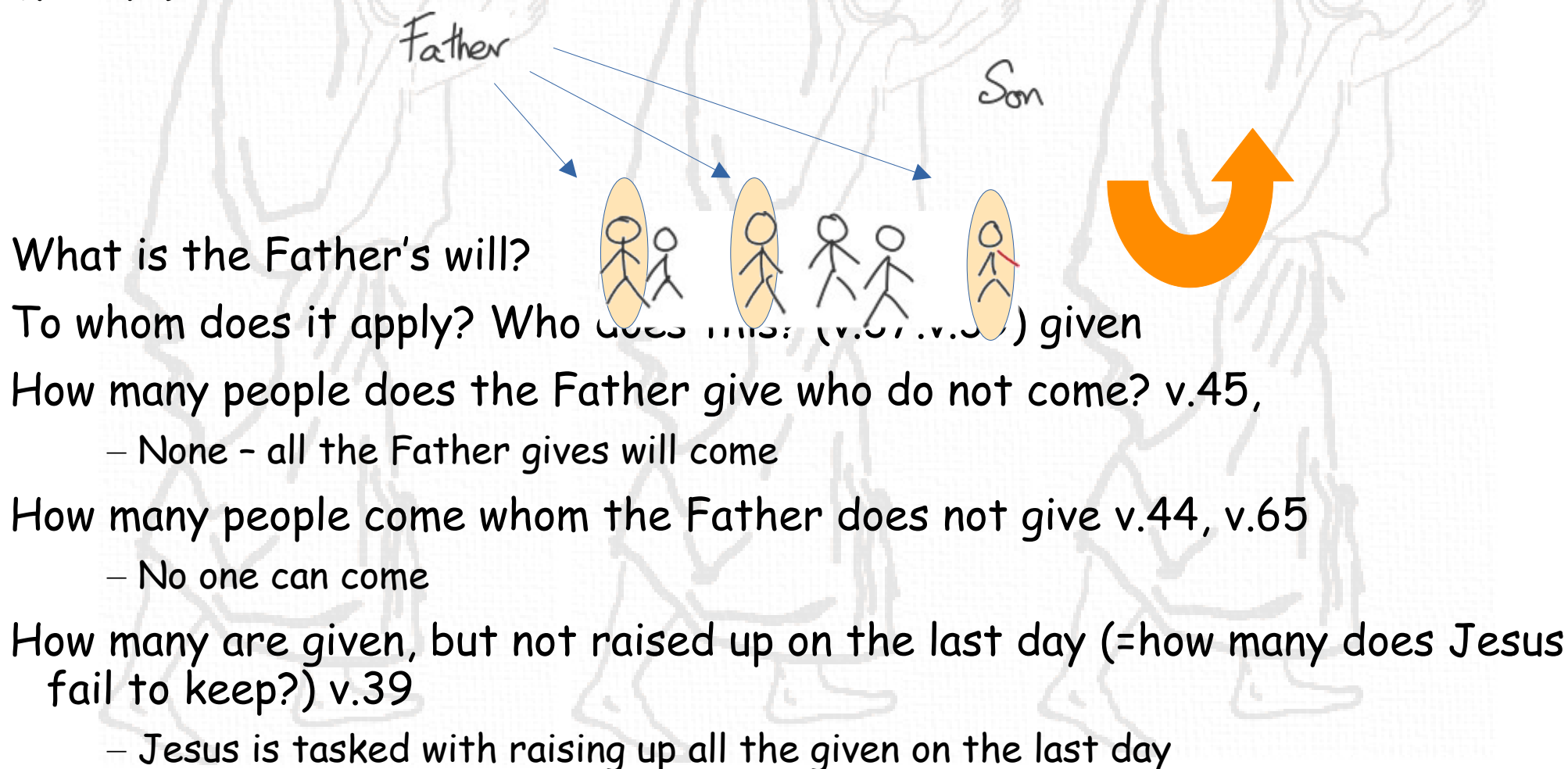
How many are given, but not raised up on the last day (=how many does Jesus fail to keep?) v.39

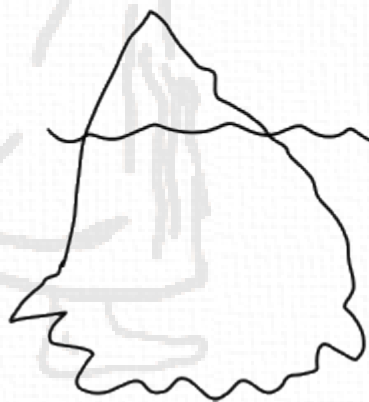

Deut 29 = 29



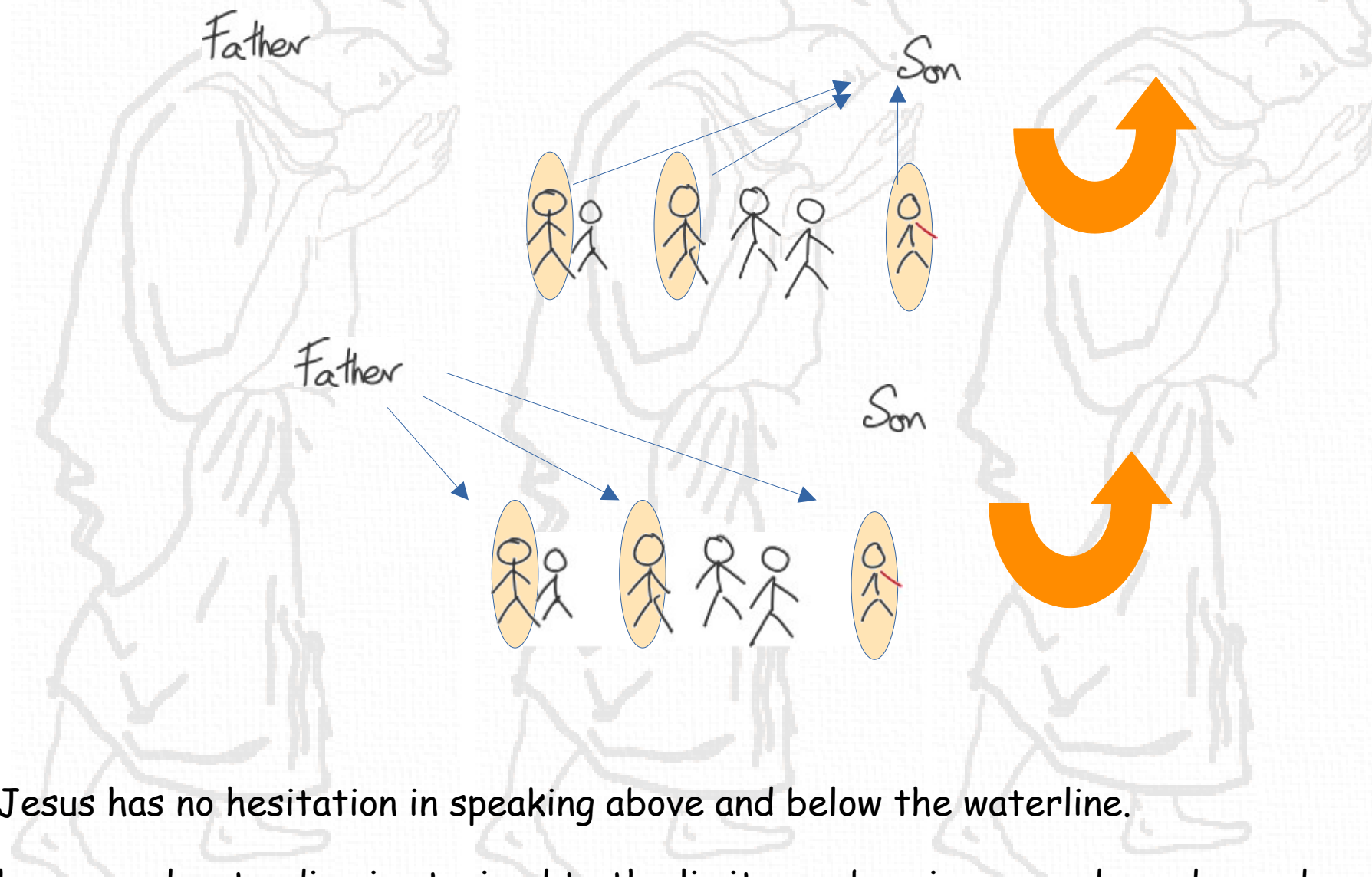

# What did Jesus say?

John 6:37,38,39,40

N.B. Father's will is stated twice - whoever believes ... whom the Father gives



Jesus has no hesitation in speaking above and below the waterline.

human understanding is strained to the limit - we bow in awe and wonder and accept what he said



# What did Jesus say?

He actually answers all these questions:

- T - how bad is sin? Are people capable of coming to Jesus without God drawing them
- U- bottom line: whose choice guarantees?
- F - can we promise anything to everyone
- L - does Christ (in his death) envisage his task is to save everyone without exception?
- I - is there anything in God's work that guarantees to succeed?
- P - can we be sure of anything for the future?

## Conclusions - implications

### 1. how humble we ought to be ("chief of sinners")

- Who am I? A sinner saved by grace!
- What do I deserve? The just and fair holy displeasure of God

### 2. How grateful we ought to be ("to the praise of his glorious grace")

- I am saved not by anything in me, but as a free gift that I just cannot account for!
- "Oh the depths of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God..." Romans 11:33

# Conclusions - implications

1. how humble we ought to be ("chief of sinners")
2. How grateful we ought to be ("to the praise of his glorious grace")
3. How confident we ought to be ("for I am convinced ..." Rom 8:38)
  - What was God doing before the foundation of the world ... planning salvation for me!
  - Will my sin make him let me go?
  - Will he forget? Is Jesus incompetent in this task to raise me up?
4. How compassionate we ought to be ("not will or effort ... mercy" Rom 9:16)
  - If God could save me, he can save anyone ...
  - Let me pray, let me seek to invite others ... let me look at other people via the grace of Christ who showed me mercy.

the hour I first believed!***

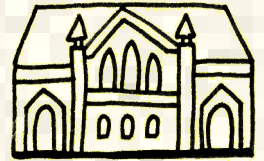
***3. Through many dangers, toils and snares
