

that we may live in his presence.

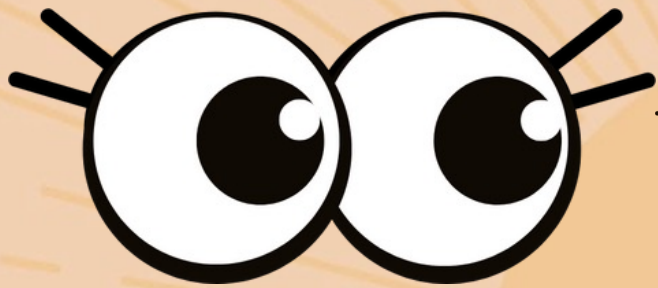
