



- hallowed be your name.


Your kingdom come,

The Christian message says


(a) if you are good enough God will let you in to heaven

- Thanks for all their care and work and service


We thank God for our new Deacons, Rosemary and Mark – Thanks for giving them gifts and a willing heart


Praise! 1148



Talk about the Bible ... Which do you agree with? "The Bible is old-fashioned and out of date" "Bible is difficult to read and makes no sense [to me]" "The Bible is unscientific and unbelievable in this modern time" "The Bible is full of contradictions" "The Bible is patriarchal and is the enemy of human flourishing ... gender and sexuality"

Talk about the Bible ...

"I love to read the Bible, it brings hope & light into my soul ... I hear God speaking"

John Wesley – old English Preacher ...

"I am a spirit come from God, and returning to God: just hovering over the great gulf; till, a few moments hence, I am no more seen; I drop into an unchangeable eternity! I want to know one thing the way to heaven; how to land safe on that happy shore. God Himself has condescended to teach the way; for this very end He came from heaven. He hath written it down in a book. O give me that book! At any price, give me the book of God!"!

What is a gospel church?

Last time: churches,

Catholic, Protestant, Pentecostal, Baptist Anglican, Methodist ...

... all different sort of churches

... does it matter? Are they all the same?

Answer: the main thing is "if you listened openly to their message would you hear <u>the gospel</u>"

What is a gospel church?

Calvary Evangelical Church

- Not to do with "jelly"!!
- Evangelical = gospel = good news
- Good news ... Christian good news / good news about Jesus Christ

What is a gospel church? The Bible

From last time:

1. what is this good news?

What the apostle Paul tells us "Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures that he was buried that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures" 1 Corinthians 15:3,4

+ close with Jesus Christ personally by repentance (= turning) and faith (believing)

2. It is important because this is the only way to be saved from our sins on the day of judgment

Good news words ..

Let's ask the questions ...

- Where is this message to be found
- What is the message?
- How do they impact?

Witness A: John 10:2-5

- The [good] shepherd of the sheep ...
 - = ??
- The sheep and the words of the shepherd
 - = they hear his voice
 - = they follow
 - = they recognise that the voice is his, and other voices do not convince them
- Where?
 - From the lips of Jesus
 - As recorded by those who heard him (apostles/witnesses)
 - As written down in Scripture
- What? About his love, his death, his resurrection (v.17)
- How impact? they follow
- ==> Bible is Jesus speaking ... I just know it's his voice
- e.g. Mary and Jesus ...

Where, what, how? Witness B: Hebrews 1:1-4, 2:1-4 – God has spoken through the prophets • Where = the Bible (Old Testament) – + God has spoken in his Son

- In these last days
- Where?
 - Lord spoke 2:3
 - Us who heard him 2:3
 - (this process confirmed by the Holy Spirit)
 - In this letter written down = Bible (New Testament)

What?

- 2:3 a such a great salvation

How impact?

- We must pay careful attention (2:1)
- We must not drift away (2:1)
- We must not ignore (2:3)
- e.g. meet my dear old friend David ... drifted away ... came back

Witness C: Romans 1:1-5, 16

- Where do we hear the gospel of God?

- From the apostle Paul (N.T. now written as Scripture)
- (apostle = authorised spokesman not fake ebay)

- Where

- In the promises of Holy Scripture v.2
- 3:21 the law and the prophets testify

- What is he saying?

• Regarding his Son

- How impact?

- v.5 call to the obedience of faith
- v.16 ... is the power of God for salvation ...

e.g. Paul in Ephesus ... Lydia, heart the Lord opened, ... Jailor ... converted in an earthquake

Q: Where are the words of God?

A1: the OT is the word of God

- Promising Jesus
- Depicting his role, his mission, his characteristics, his salvation
- e.g. as King, as Lamb, as changer of hearts, as bringer of God, as Hope of the new age

- A2: the NT is the word of God

- Declaring Jesus
- His own words and works
- The full confirmation, explanation by the apostles/apostolic group
- What the Bible says God says!

"Give me this book"

- "read this book" – get into this book – pour it into our souls to that we eat, sleep, live, by this book

Q: what is the message of God? A: how to be saved from sin by Jesus Christ - From its guilt - forgiveness • Unbearable guilt ... the charges are dropped! From its shame – cleansing • Woman at the well - From its power - new life • Shows us the right way to live From its ultimate judgment – no condemnation on the day of judgment

Q: how does it impact?

A: power of God

- God made everything by speaking!!
- "is not my word like a fire, declares the LORD, and like a hammer that breaks rock in pieces" Jeremiah 23:29
- To bring to new birth ... ("Born again through the living and enduring word of God" 1 Peter 1:23)
- To raise to new life ... e.g. Lazarus
- To transform our lives ... to do deep surgery on our motives and desires (Hebrews 4:12)

- To mould us into the likeness of Christ ...

The gospel ... the Bible

A gospel church receives, lives, tells the gospel of Jesus Christ


- Are you part of that community?
- Has this message of Jesus got hold of your life?
 - Surrendered? Believed? If not, why not?

A gospel church

- Takes its stand on the gospel by believing the Bible
- "what the Bible says, God says"
- They see everything through the spectacles of Scripture
- Hear his voice and follow
- Yield to his word, trust his word, love his word
- By his word they are under the touch of God upon their lives
- In his word they meet and know the risen Saviour
- What other sort of church would we want to be?
- What in this life could be better?
