The Spirit of Wisdom

Are we over familiar with the Lord's Prayer?
It comes in the Sermon on the Mount
Wisdom rather than prophecy

See, my servant will act wisely (Is. 52:13a)

I will pray with my spirit, but I will also pray with my mind (1 Cor. 14:15)



The Spirit of Wisdom

Are we over familiar with the Lord's Prayer?

ACTS (Adoration, Confession, Thanksgiving, Supplication) does not really fit!

What Jesus is doing here is not so much giving us a pattern prayer as clearing up common misconceptions about prayer



Some key issues

- 1. The purpose of prayer is not to change God's mind (vv7,8)
- 2. Location matters, but not perhaps in the way you thought
- 3. The quantity of words doesn't matter (v5), but focus and persistence does



1. The purpose of prayer is not to change God's mind (vv7,8)

The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." (NIV Jas 5:16b)

But God is not a vending machine. The prupose of prayer is not so much to change God's mind as to change ours! As we pray, we become aligned with, and involved in, God's programme



2. Location matters, but not perhaps in the way you thought

The proper location for praying is where the real action takes place (v6)

Who are you praying to?

Where is the recipient of the prayer to be found?

What action are you expecting?

Heaven and earth: the Kingdom dynamic (9,10)

Matthew 6:31-34



3. The quantity of words doesn't matter (v7), but focus and persistence does

Luke 18:1-8

When the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on the earth?" (NIV Lk 18:8b)
